

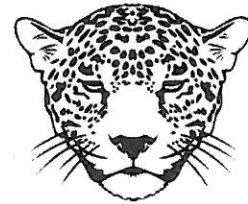

## **BUDGET VOTE AND ELECTION POSTCARD**

The Johnsburg Central School District Budget Vote and Election is scheduled for June 9, 2020.

A Budget Hearing will take place on June 1, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. The meeting will be held as a WebEx and the link to join the meeting will be available on the school's website, [www.johnsburgcsd.org](http://www.johnsburgcsd.org). as well as our Johnsburg Central School's Facebook page.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 202.26 issued on Friday, May 1, 2020 by Governor Andrew Cuomo, all voting for the June 9, 2020 election will be done by absentee ballot such that the school district must send absentee ballots with a postage paid return envelope to each "qualified voter." A qualified voter is someone who is a US citizen, 18 years of age, a resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the vote, and not disqualified by any reason set forth in NYS Election Law §5-106.

Qualified voters on the most recent years' poll lists will be automatically sent an absentee ballot. Anyone who meets the definition of a "qualified voter," but does not believe he/she will be on the School District's poll list, which contains the names of residents who voted in the last four years' elections, please contact the District Clerk, Ms. Cindy Homer, by email at [chomer@johnsburgcsd.org](mailto:chomer@johnsburgcsd.org) as soon as possible to ensure timely receipt of an absentee ballot for the 2020 annual meeting/election. All completed ballots must be mailed and received by the District Clerk no later than 5 pm. On Tuesday, June 9, 2020.
